DON'T RISK AN ACCIDENTAL FIRE

Never use or store flammable materials in any room where a spark or open flame could ignite them. *Flammable items include:*

- Gasoline (in a can or lawnmower)
- Solvents
- Acetone
- Denatured alcohol
- Paints and thinners
- Camp stove fuel
- Lighter fluid
- Adhesives

Fumes from these and other flammable liquids can travel a great distance and catch fire, causing serious bodily injury or even death.

BE SAFE. FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE PRECAUTIONS.

Read the label of any product you suspect might be flammable.

Use and store all flammable products away from any gas appliances and other potential sources of fire or flame.

Warn all family members of the dangers of careless flammable liquid storage.
