

CUSTOMER NOTICE

On April 23, 2009, Atmos Energy Corporation's Mid-Tex Division ("Atmos Energy" or "the Company"), filed with the Texas Railroad Commission ("Commission") a Statement of Intent to increase its natural gas rates and implement a new schedule of rates and riders applicable to all customers within all unincorporated areas served by the Mid-Tex Division. The proposed effective date of the requested rate changes is May 28, 2009. If approved, the proposed changes will affect approximately 43,414 residential, 2,016 commercial, and 74 industrial and transportation customers. Pursuant to Chapter 16, §7.115(33) of the TEXAS ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, the proposed rates are not specifically keyed to the rates charged in any incorporated area.

If approved, the proposed rates will increase the Company's annual revenues for the unincorporated areas of its Mid-Tex Division by \$1.3 million or 3.28%, including

natural gas costs, or 11.32% excluding gas cost. The proposed change in rates constitutes a "major change" as that term is defined by Section 104.101 of the Texas Utilities Code. In addition, the Company seeks to recover all rate case expenses as allowed by law. The exact amount of rate case expenses will not be known until the case is completed.

Based on the proposed rate design, the average monthly bill for each customer class within the unincorporated areas of the Mid-Tex Division will increase by the amount and percent shown in the table to the left:

The proposed increase to rates broken down by the customer and consumption charge for each customer class is shown in the table below:

In addition to the rate revisions in Rate Schedules R, C, I, and T, other proposed tariff changes include changes to Rider Gas Cost Recovery (“GCR”), Rider Weather Normalization Adjustment (“WNA”) and Rider Conservation & Energy Efficiency (“CEE”). The Company proposes to revise its Rider GCR to allow the recovery of gains and losses, as well as transaction costs associated with financial hedging transactions. In addition, Atmos Energy proposes to modify its Rider WNA to update the heat load and base load factors and change the current billing rate basis from Ccf to an Mcf basis. Changes to the Rider CEE are also proposed in order to conform certain language in the Rider CEE to language in effect in the vast majority of the Mid-Tex Division service area: add language in the Rider CEE to clarify the time period within which the Company must file certain reports with the Commission; clarify low income eligibility guidelines; clarify that gas plumbing services will be provided under the program, and; change the per residence weatherization allowance from \$200.00 to \$1,500.00.
