

2021 Custom Energy Efficiency Program Colorado

Eligibility Assessment Form (EAF)

Atmos Energy offers an Eligibility Assessment to customers who are interested in the installation of energy efficiency upgrades to their facility. The Eligibility Assessment will determine eligibility for financial incentives offered by Atmos Energy.

Eligibility Assessment Process

Step 1 – Submit completed EAF to custom@mesapointenergy.com.

Once received, the Program Administrator will review the application. This may include a phone interview and/or a brief on-site walk through depending on the complexity of the facility.

Step 2 – If eligible, apply for an incentive to implement energy efficiency measures, or an Energy Audit incentive.

The Program Administrator will send an email notification the eligibility assessment results. If eligible, the customer next fills out an Implementation / Installation Form (IIF) which outlines the scope of proposed energy efficiency measures. If an energy audit is recommended, the customer completes a Technical Study Form (TSF).

Atmos Energy Custom Energy-Efficiency Financial Incentive Program is available January 1 through December 31, 2021 or until funding is fully allocated.
