

**NOTICE OF REVISION TO ATMOS ENERGY’S COLORADO P.U.C. NO. 7 – GAS
TARIFF ON LESS THAN STATUTORY NOTICE**

You are hereby notified that Atmos Energy Corporation (“Atmos Energy” or the “Company”) has filed an application with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission of the State of Colorado (“Commission”) requesting an order authorizing the Company to implement the new, mandatory monthly Energy Assistance System Benefit Charge (“EASBC”) on less than 30 days’ notice, effective October 1, 2021. This monthly gas charge is in accordance with House Bill 21-1105 (“HB 21-1105”), which was signed into law on July 7, 2021. Unless customers opt-out or are otherwise exempted, this monthly charge is applicable to all residential, commercial, and irrigation consumers in Atmos Energy’s Colorado service areas.

The purpose of the revision of the Company’s tariff is to implement the new monthly EASBC required by HB 21-1105, beginning October 1, 2021. The EASBC is a flat monthly charge that shall adjust annually each October 1. In 2021 the rate will be \$0.50 and in 2022 the rate will adjust to \$0.75. The current average monthly bills and proposed average monthly bills with the EASBC are as follows:

Anyone who desires may file written comments or objections to the proposed action. Written comments or objections shall be filed with the Commission, 1560 Broadway, Suite 250, Denver, Colorado, 80202-5143 or filed at <https://puc.colorado.gov/puccomments>. The Commission will consider all written comments and objections submitted prior to the evidentiary hearing on the application if one is held. The filing of written comments or objections by itself will not allow you to participate as a party in any proceeding on the proposed action. If you wish to participate as a party in this matter, you must file written intervention documents in accordance with Rule 1401 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure or any applicable Commission order.

The Commission may hold a hearing to determine what rates, rules and regulations will be authorized. If a hearing is held, the Commission may suspend the proposed rates, rules or regulations. The rates, rules and regulations ultimately authorized by the Commission may or may not be the same as those proposed and may include rates that are higher or lower.

The Commission may hold a public hearing in addition to an evidentiary hearing on the application. If such a hearing is held, members of the public may attend and make statements even if they did not file comments, objections or interventions. If the application is uncontested or unopposed, the Commission may determine the matter without hearing and without further notice. Anyone desiring information regarding if and when a hearing may be held shall submit a written request to the Commission or, alternatively, shall contact the Consumer Affairs section of the

Commission at 303-894-2070 or 1-800-456-0858. Notices of proposed hearings will be available on the Commission website under “News Releases” or through the Commission’s e-filing system.
