

NOTICE OF FILING BY ATMOS ENERGY CORPORATION TO RECOVER THE COSTS
ASSOCIATED WITH THE FEBRUARY 2021 EXTREME WEATHER EVENT THROUGH
THE COMPANY'S GAS COST ADJUSTMENT MECHANISM

You are hereby notified that Atmos Energy Corporation (“Atmos Energy” or the “Company”) has filed with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) for regarding the gas costs associated with the February 2021 extreme weather event in Proceeding No. 21A-0186G. Atmos Energy is proposing that it be allowed to recover these costs in a manner that would increase average residential customer bills by no more than \$6.00 per month over the term of the recovery across all of its rate areas. Atmos Energy has not applied to adjust its gas cost adjustment rates in this proceeding, instead any change in gas costs recovered through customer bills would take place in a separate subsequent proceeding. The filing is available for examination at the Company’s business office located at 1555 Blake Street, Suite 400, Denver, Colorado, 80202 and at the Commission at 1560 Broadway, Suite 250, Denver, Colorado 80202. Atmos Energy is a Texas and Virginia corporation, in good standing in all respects, with its principal office and place of business at P.O. Box 650205, 1800 Three Lincoln Centre, 5430 LBJ Freeway, Dallas, Texas 75265-0205.

Anyone who desires may file written comments or objections with the Commission. The Commission’s mailing address is 1560 Broadway, Suite 250, Denver, Colorado, 80202 and its e-mail address is dora_puc_complaints@state.co.us. The Commission will consider all written comments and objections submitted prior to the evidentiary hearing on the filing. The filing of a written objection by itself will not allow you to participate as a party in any proceeding on the proposed action. If you wish to participate as a party in this matter, you must file an intervention in accordance with Rule 1401 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure or any applicable Commission order.

The Commission may hold a public hearing in addition to an evidentiary hearing on the filing and if such a hearing is held members of the public may attend and make statements even if they did not file comments, objections, or an intervention. If the filing is uncontested or unopposed, the Commission may determine the matter without a hearing and without further notice.
